## HEIGHT DIVISIONS

### **Jump Height Card Process**

There is a section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the Dogs To Be Measured List. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in. However, exhibitors are still required to have the jump height card with them at the trials. Exhibitors needing to be measured, are advised to be present on Wednesday afternoon or early each morning to allow time to be measured, Owners are responsible for entering the proper height divisions. Refer to the AKC website at [www.akc.org/events/agility/jump\\_height\\_card.cfm](http://www.akc.org/events/agility/jump_height_card.cfm) for complete rules and policy regarding jump height cards and measurements. We usually have a VMO and / or AKC Rep present, therefore all dogs without a valid Jump Height Card would be required to be measured.

## **ENTRY FEES**

**\$24 for 1st entry each dog each day and \$14 for 2nd entry each dog each day.**  
Entry fees include a \$3 AKC recording fee for each entry each day.  
Please note that increased entry fees are due solely to increased AKC fees. We have not increased entry fees in more than 7 years, except to cover the increases in AKC fees.

## PRIZES

Rosettes (blue, red, yellow, white) will be awarded to the 1st through 4th place dogs in each jump height in each class. Green qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. Medallions will be awarded to those completing requirements for a title at these trials. Custom designed MACH bars and rosettes will be awarded to exhibitors completing requirements for a MACH or a PAX at these trials. **No prizes or ribbons will be mailed. Ribbons, rosettes, and / or prizes must be picked up no later that ½ hour after the last run on Sunday afternoon. Any unclaimed ribbons, rosettes, and prizes will become the property of the host clubs.**

## SCHEDULE

Judges' briefings and walkthroughs will begin each day at 7:00 AM. The first run each day will be at 7:30 AM, beginning with declared conflicts in the first two classes followed immediately by the first scheduled jump height. Height order and class order in each ring, each day, is as below:

## OBSTACLES

Obstacles used will be those as defined in The AKC Regulations for Agility Trials. Electronic timing will be in use.

**Note: Weaves poles will be spaced 24 inches on center.**

## ENTRIES ACCEPTED ON FIRST RECEIVED BASIS

Entries for a maximum of ten (10) dogs are allowed in each envelope submitted to the Trial Secretary. Envelopes containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to sender. However, it will be possible to be accepted for some days and not others as each day fills at a different rate since exhibitors may enter any combination of dates. Those not accepted for all days that they have entered will be placed on a waiting list and will be notified by the Trial Secretary. Those exhibitors will have the option of remaining on the waiting list or canceling their entries for the days they were accepted. Cancellations must be received prior to the closing date and time.

## On-Line Entries

During the first 48 hours 20% (184) of the total entries (per day) may be accepted on-line.**

## **PerryBucks are back!!!**

Throughout the years we have been hosting agility trials in Perry, we have been fortunate to have outstanding volunteers to assist in putting on the trials. We would not be able to host these trials without the help of those volunteers. As a token of our appreciation, we have conducted a workers' raffle each day with cash prizes awarded to those whose tickets are drawn. While this provided a cash prize to a lucky few, most volunteers went unrewarded other than receiving lunch.

In an effort to provide a small token of appreciation to each volunteer, we introduced PerryBucks at the April, 2009 trials. PerryBucks will be given to volunteers for each assignment that they work. PerryBucks will be valid toward entry fees for future Atlanta KC and/or Chattahoochee Weimaraner Club Agility Events (in Perry or elsewhere). A minimum of 2 PerryBucks will be awarded for each volunteer assignment. For assignments estimated to be longer than 1 hour, 1 PerryBuck will be awarded for each additional half hour beyond an hour. The clubs expect that we will be returning approximately the same total amount to volunteers as we did with the worker raffles, but it will be more equitably divided. This also eliminates the requirement that volunteers remain until the end of the day to have an opportunity for a reward. We will continue to provide a complimentary lunch to those working 2 or more hours each day.

**We will give a PerryBucks bonus to volunteers who work the last assignments on Sunday afternoon. Volunteers who work the Open JWW or Novice JWW classes, or the Excellent JWW class, 12 inches jump height or lower, will receive double the normal amount of PerryBucks.**

Please sign up for specific classes and assignments using our on line worker database. The database will be available for signups concurrent with the opening of entries. **The database can be accessed at [www.TrialToaster.com](http://www.TrialToaster.com) and the event code will be 2011080803. We will also give a PerryBucks bonus to volunteers who use our online worker volunteer database. 2 PerryBucks will be given to each volunteer for each day that they sign up for at least one volunteer assignment.** Of course, they must also fulfill that assignment.

## CONFLICTS

It is the exhibitors' responsibility to be at the ring with their dog when it is their turn to run. We would like to accommodate each and every conflict but that will more than likely be impossible and you may have to make a choice. We believe the following will resolve the majority of legitimate conflicts.

Conflicts within a jump height will be resolved by the Gate Steward. Handlers with multiple dogs in a jump height may have the first dog moved forward or the last moved later. The order of the dogs in question may not be changed.

Otherwise, exhibitors with conflicts in the first two classes each day will run at 7:30 AM. Conflicts in other than the first class in each ring, in most cases, will be accommodated by running first in your class. Only in the most dire of circumstances may a handler in any of the Excellent Classes be allowed to run after their jump height has been completed.

Requests for changes in assigned running order are granted at the discretion of the trial committee and only when that change does not disrupt the smooth flow of the trial. You must declare your conflict the day prior, ie, Friday for a Saturday conflict. If you have a conflict for Thursday, check in with us Wednesday afternoon when you arrive or notify us via e-mail no later than 6:00 PM, Monday, April 11, 2011. You will fill out a brief "conflict" form. This will insure that we will be able to pull your scribe sheet and have it ready for 7:30 AM or other designated time for your run. Exhibitors who are not at the line at their assigned time to run and have not declared a conflict and had it approved will be marked absent.

If you declare a conflict, and are assigned a new running time or order, that will be the time you are required to run. If you are not present at that time you will be marked absent and will not be permitted to run at any other time.

See a Trial Committee Member at the Trial Chairperson table to register your conflict. Do not ask at the Scorekeeping Table.

## NOTICES TO EXHIBITORS

**The Trial Secretary must receive move-ups for the first day entered by 6:00 PM ET on Monday, April 11, 2011.** Day-to-day move-ups will be accepted until the conclusion of awards on the day prior to each trial. Move-ups are subject to any numerical limits in the higher class. Move-ups may be faxed to 770-667-1878 or e-mailed to [Trialsec@PerryAgility.com](mailto:Trialsec@PerryAgility.com) . No telephone requests will be honored.

Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate, and **legible** information on their entry forms. Illegible or incomplete entries cannot be entered in the trials. All entries must be made on an Official AKC Entry Form (using the new form effective 09/10) and must include the agreements on the reverse. Exhibitors using an entry form other than the current Official AKC Entry Form may be required to fill out and sign the proper form at the trial. Exhibitors are reminded of Chapter 11, Section 5 of The Rules Applying to Dog Shows that states that any entry which specifies any condition as to its acceptance shall not be accepted. Full and immediately negotiable funds must accompany each entry. Checks will be deposited if any of the entries accompanying it are accepted and refunds will be made for entries not accepted.

Catalogs will be made available on a pre-ordered basis. Four-day combined catalogs are \$15.00 each. Please make sure you check the box on the entry form if you want a catalog and include an additional \$15 in your check. A limited number of catalogs will be available for purchase at the trial. Running orders will be available at no cost.

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

*Puppies under 6 months are strictly prohibited from the grounds.*

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the Trial Committee.

**BE A RESPONSIBLE dog owner and exhibitor. Pick up after your dog on the grounds and at your hotel site and encourage others to do the same.**

## NOTICES TO EXHIBITORS

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

**All dogs must be on a leash at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area. This applies to ALL areas on the Ag Center grounds!**

Pinch/prong and electrical collars (dummy or not), head halters and special training collars are not allowed anywhere on the trial grounds.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run.

Since Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials, the club will refund all but \$10 of the daily entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must be notified of such claim for refund by 5:00 PM ET the day prior to each trial day. Documentation by a veterinarian (on business letterhead) is required and must be supplied by the end of the trial day to receive a refund. **Please note this is the only allowable reason for cancelling entries after the closing date.**

**For entries cancelled prior to the closing date and time, an administrative fee of \$10 per dog will be deducted from any refund due.**

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$25 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

## **NOTIFICATIONS**

For entries submitted with legible and valid e-mail addresses, preliminary acknowledgments will be sent following receipt of your entry. Please allow 5 business days from receipt of your entry for the acknowledgment of receipt and status. The final confirmation, with running orders (counts by height and class) and arm band numbers, will be sent after closing. All of the above notifications will be via e-mail. Obviously, your email address must be printed legibly to be able to receive email notifications. Entries without e-mail addresses will be sent only a final confirmation via USPS. It is suggested for those exhibitors to send a self addressed postcard to be notified of their status upon receipt of their entry.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners SM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option effective April 1, 2010. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

## Training Opportunity!

Due to the AKC Regulations regarding matches, we will not be holding a match on Wednesday afternoon. However, AKC now permits training on the trial equipment on the day prior to a trial. We will offer the opportunity for training on Wednesday afternoon, April 13, beginning as soon as the equipment is unloaded and set, approximately 2:30 PM.

Nested courses will be set in each ring for those wishing to practice a course. Since this is a training opportunity, and not a match, there will be no judging of any run. Nor, is there any requirement to run the set course.

Training time will be available in 2½ minute increments at \$10 each. No more than 2 consecutive increments per handler will be allowed. We will rotate jump heights in each ring to allow greatest efficiency. We will continue the jump height rotation in each ring as long as anyone wishes more time, or until 5:30 PM.

No preregistration is required. Training time will be available on a first come, first served basis.

Handlers may use training aids, however absolutely no food treats will be allowed in the rings. Abusive training or harsh corrections will not be permitted.
